


1. There are many things I will hear in church.

A censor is an important instrument the priest uses to burn incense.


18. After church, I could ask the priest to look at the censor and explain to me the importance of the censor.








19. If any of these sounds hurt my ears, I will try not to cover my ears

20. I can let my parents or church friend know it is too loud.




Maybe they can bring my earphones next time or use headphones left at church.
