How to use: This social ecosystem mapping is based on the system from Urie Bronfenbrenner adapted by Nicole Ja. The definitions provided for each level were created by Smiti Nathan to beter understand how what to map.

This process is to help our youth better understand their place in the world around them, especially in the context of a part of a human in an eco-system and then as a Christian within God's creation.

As described within the the actual session, the groups are asked to work through this looking at the church as the "individual". Then, the youth can work through the mapping as themselves as the "individual. Each time they work through the mapping, give the your youth time to discuss the process and how this helped them think about their place in creation and as caretakers.
